Treatment in Dogs



What is Laser therapy?

Cold laser therapy is a non-invasive procedure that uses light to stimulate cell regeneration and increase blood and lymphatic circulation. Therefore, lasers effectively help to decrease inflammation and edema, and help to control pain.

What is Laser therapy used for?

Laser therapy is now being used as part of treatment regimens for dogs with arthritis, tendon or soft tissue injuries, or delayed wound healing. Newer uses include:

- anal sacculitis
- otitis externa
- lick granulomas
- post operative incision treatment

The good news is that your dog does not need to be clipped or shaved prior to laser therapy, and there is no need for sedation. In fact, most dogs find the whole procedure relaxing.

How long is Laser therapy treatment?

Depending on the area being treated, and the frequency being used, treatment may take anywhere from a few minutes to 15-20 minutes. Treatments may be done multiple times per day, to once monthly.

What is the cost of Laser therapy?

The cost for laser therapy sessions range from \$15.00 to \$35.00 depending on the area being treated and the length of time for the procedure.
